ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NO. 94-03

Effective July 1, 1994, the following policy shall apply to allocate payments made by probationers. Payments shall be allocated in the following order of priority:

1. Restitution
2. Judicial Collection Enhancement Fund (JCEF)
3. Probation Fee
- 4A. Fine and surcharge of 57% which is distributed by the Clerk of the Court pursuant to the formula established under House Bill 2088 filed 4-23-93; or
- 4B. Court reimbursement
 - a) Attorney Fees
 - b) Prosecution Fees
 - c) Detention Fees
 - d) Court Cost in General
 - e) Counseling
 - f) Transportation Expenditures

A pro rata distribution of restitution payments shall be made to multiple private victims except when the amount is too small to justify processing expenses. Restitution shall be disbursed first to private victims and then to institutional victims.

The Clerk's Office is directed to confer with the Chief Probation Officer for further clarification, when needed, to help carry out the financial Court Orders.

LA PAZ COUNTY POLICY
FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF PAYMENTS
RECEIVED ON ADULT CRIMINAL CASES

The following policy shall apply in distributing payments made by Probationers effective July 1, 1994. A pro rata distribution of restitution payments shall be made to multiple private victims except when the amount is too small to justify processing expenses. Restitution shall be disbursed first to private victims, then to institutional victims.

1. Restitution
2. Judicial Collection Enhancement Fund (JCEF)
3. Probation Fee
- 4A. Fine and S/C of 57% which is distributed by the Clerk of the Court pursuant to the formula established under House Bill 2088 filed 4-23-93.

Or

- 4B. Court reimbursement
 - A. Attorney Fees
 - B. Prosecution Fees
 - C. Detention Fees
 - D. Court Cost in General
 - E. Counseling
 - F. Transportation Expenditures

The Clerk's Office is directed to the Probation Department for further clarification, when needed, to help carry out the financial Court Orders.
