The Arizona Supreme Court issued Administrative Order Number 2022-34, terminating other orders related to the COVID-19 public health emergency and returning Arizona courts to normal operations, while encouraging the continued use of technological and resource innovations used during the pandemic to promote participation in, and minimize the costs of, court proceedings.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority granted to this Court by Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order Number 2022-34,

**IT IS ORDERED** terminating the COVID-19 public health emergency procedures and policies set forth for La Paz County courts in Administrative Order Nos. S1500AO-20200001, S1500AO-20200002, S1500AO-20200003, S1500AO-202100004, S1500AO-202100005, and S1500AO-202100008.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the continued use of technological and resource innovations established during the COVID-19 public health emergency for **electronic filing of documents and remote and in-person hearings** shall continue as set forth in **Administrative Order Nos. S1500AO-202200003 and S1500AO-202200004**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this order replaces Administrative Order No. S1500AO-202100008.
