### AN ACT

RELATING TO COURTS AND CIVIL PROCEEDINGS; ESTABLISHING THE DOCUMENT STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL CONVERSION FUND FOR THE CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT; PRESCRIBING ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND; PRESCRIBING FUND PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR FEES; PRESCRIBING DISPOSITION OF MONIES; AMENDING TITLE 12, CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 8, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 12-284.01, AND PROVIDING FOR DELAYED REPEAL OF SECTION 12-284.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AS ADDED BY THIS ACT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona: Section 1. Title 12, chapter 2, article 8, Arizona Statutes, is amended by adding section 12-284.01, to read: 12-284.01. Document storage and retrieval conversion

A. A DOCUMENT STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL CONVERSION FUND FOR THE CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT IS ESTABLISHED CONSISTING OF MONIES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION.

-B. THE PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND AND EXPEND MONIES IN THE FUND, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, IN ORDER TO DEFRAY THE COST OF CONVERTING THE CLERK'S DOCUMENT STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL SYSTEM TO MICROGRAPHICS OR COMPUTER AUTOMATION.

C. IN ADDITION TO THE FILING OR APPEARANCE FEE CHARGED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE @ OF THIS TITLE OR SECTION 12-1705, 25-303 OR 25-311.01. THE PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT MAY ASSESS EACH PERSON REQUIRED TO PAY A FILING OR APPEARANCE FEE UNDER SUCH ARTICLE OR SECTIONS AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF NOT TO EXCEED FIVE DOLLARS. ALL MONIES RECEIVED FROM THE ADDITIONAL FEE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE TRANSMITTED TO THE COUNTY TREASURER AND PLACED IN THE DOCUMENT STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL CONVERSION FUND FOR THE CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

D. THE ADDITIONAL FEES REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION ARE EXEMPT FROM SECTIONS 12-305 AND 38-810. Law Library

E. THE CLERK SHALL ANNUALLY SUBMIT TO THE PRESIDING SUDGE THE AMOUNT OF PROJECTED REVENUES TO BE RAISED FOR THE DOCUMENT STORAGE AND RETRIEVAL CONVESSION FUND PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION. IF PROJECTED REVENUES

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OF THE FUND ARE DEEMED INSUFFICIENT TO PAY FOR CONVERSION COSTS, FUND MONIES MAY ACCUMULATE UNTIL SUFFICIENT MONIES ARE AVAILABLE IN THE FUND.

Sec. 2. Delayed repeal

Section 12-284.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act, is repealed from and after June 30, 1991. Monies remaining in the document storage and retrieval conversion fund after this date must be expended in a manner consistent with this act.

Sec. 3. Emergency

To preserve the public peace, health and safety it is necessary that this act become immediately operative. It is therefore declared to be an emergency measure, to take effect as provided by law.
